Great start up. 312 students are enrolled. Throughout the year this number grows (323 in 2021/22).

Less restrictions, no cohorting. The first assembly just took place. Terry Fox Run: K runs on the field. Grades 1-3 run up cougar creek with staggered times per grade.

CRPS is starting to have elders come into the school. 4 elders, once per month, connected with curriculum.

# Background on Class split:
