What is the Food for Learning Program?

The Food for Learning Program is a voluntary program available to students of Elizabeth Rummel School, made possible by a grant from the Government of Alberta. Who is eligible for the program?

The program is intended to support the children of families who are having difficulty providing a nutritional, balanced lunch for their child. It is available, free of charge, to children who attend Elizabeth Rummel School.
