Dear Parents/Guardians,

Mr. Brian Wityshyn (Principal) and Mrs. Nicole Skwara (Assistant Principal) and the rest of the ERS staff are thrilled to work with the ERS community for another year!

The beginning of the school year always marks a time of promise and possibility, and 2024-25 is no exception! With our dedicated staff and a supportive community, we will continue to nurture a culture of excellence, while attending to the needs of the whole child in a safe and caring environment.

ERS School hours are between 8:25am - 3:06pm.

During the first day back on August 26th, teachers will be greeting grades one to four students at the following locations between 8:15 to 8:30 am:

Grade 1: By the Grade One (east) doors on Cougar Creek Drive.

Grade 2: Up the stairs on the West Side of the School.

Grade 3 and 3: (Ms. Brunet and Mrs. Billings) Side door across from the stairs leading up to the play structure.

Grade 3: (Mme. McKenzie & Mme. Delorme): Back of the school on the East side tarmac area (beside the new Gaga Pit).

Grade 4: Back of the school on the West side tarmac area (beside the new Gaga Pit)

Kindergarten students will follow the staggered entry schedule that they have already received and will enter the school through the front entrance. Staff will be on hand to help direct you to the correct classroom.

Classroom Assignments and First Day Back

As mentioned in an earlier email, you can access your child's teacher placement by logging onto <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u> by 5pm on Friday, August 23. All staff have put forth significant effort into building balanced classrooms and we ask that you trust our professional judgment in this matter.

Kindergarten

We will be contacting Kindergarten families to inform them about who their child's teacher is on August 28th. The first full day for all Kindergarten students will be September 3rd.
