Thank you to the Parent Council for the Orff Instrument funding. 15 xylophones and some non-pitched percussion instruments have been introduced to lesson plans. This has opened up new learning through manipulative, hands-on activities that build a rhythm, melody, and musical notation reading

Parent Teacher Conferences went very well last week. Thank you to the parent council for supplying food and snacks for the staff over the few evenings

A parent survey was sent out and we had 121 responses already. Another survey was sent out to look and see how Canadian Rockies Public Schools (CRPS) wants to improve communication with parents. Please take this short survey of 11 questions. The survey takes 5-10 minutes, Individual responses are confidential. The survey closes November 18, 2024 at 4 PM

Great news, the number of students working at Grade level in both our literacy and numeracy has improved this year. Math 84%-87% Reading 73%-86% The reason is beginning intervention earlier, starting in Kindergarten rather than Grade 2 and the continuation of the numeracy and literacy staff supports, UFLY (A balanced literacy program)

Professional development this month is focusing on neurodiversity. Neurodiversity is a word to explain the unique ways people's brains work. While everyone's brain works develops similarly no two brains function just alike. Being neurodivergent means having a brain that works differently from the average or "neurotypical" person. We

are also looking at Executive functioning (Eg, reasoning, working memory and self-control

The winter concert date for Grades 2-3 will be on December 4th with an afternoon rehearsal at 1:30 PM and a performance at 6:30 PM. Grades 1-4 will perform in the Spring and Kindergarten will attend the annual Banff Springs Hotel Christmas event.

There is a musical proposal from Grace to update the speaker system to help with ease of portability, sound quality, and Bluetooth capability. A new system would come in handy for school events such as concerts, assemblies, and special guest performances/visitors (Surprise visitors in the New Year but it is top secret!)

An ask for parent council support is funding to purchase new books for the library geared towards the Grade 4 students

1 year term deposit matured, received \$1818.53 in interest. Reinvested as follows

- \$30,000 in a 1 year non-redeemable term at 4.35% (Matures Oct 18th, 2025.
- 2x \$10,000 plus 1x\$5000 in 1-year redeemable terms at 2.5%, if we redeem early we get 1.25%.-matures Oct 18th, 2025, if we don't redeem them early.
- \$5000 in a 2.5% 6 month term which will mature April 28, 2025.

We have officially postponed casino to Q1 2028
